****IMPORTANT: PLEASE SEE BELOW INFORMATION REGARDING EMBROIDERY ON WHITE GARMENTS.****

Below, you will find sample artwork you can expect from us to ensure you are satisfied with your logo before we proceed with embroidery or printing. We send all new logos (those not created using our online designer or for orders of 5 or more garments) to customers for approval within 48 hours. Please check your junk folders and contact us if you do not receive it within this timeframe.

GUIDELINES FOR A SPEEDY SERVICE

- High-Quality Image: Ensure your image is of good quality.
- Stitch Count: It should be under or around 8,000 stitches for left chest or sleeve size.
- Order and Payment: Place and pay for your order either online or via telephone (01744 814004). We will then create your file and send it to you for approval. We do not proceed with the logo until you are satisfied.
- Complex Designs: If your design is complex or exceeds 8,000 stitches, there may be an additional charge. Please call us with any queries.
- Design Changes: Making changes to the original design may delay your order.

POSITIONING TOLERANCES

PLEASE NOTE: Any print or logo service will have a plus or minus tolerance of 10% in terms of positioning. Garment printing is a dynamic process, and due to different types of fabrics and garments, logos may need to be adjusted to different positions to suit the product they are being applied to.

Once approved we cannot guarantee any changes, and any such alterations may incur additional costs. Delays in approval may affect production and delivery times. Colours may appear differently from screen to screen or if the proof is printed out on paper. Pantone/thread colours are matched from universal swatch books. However, please be aware that production processes may at times have a slight effect on how colours appear on garments. PLEASE NOTE ANY FINE ELEMENTS IN THE ARTWORK MAY LOSE DETAIL DURING THE PRINTING PROCESS

Important Information Regarding White Garments

At Ditto Custom Clothing, we prioritise high-quality embroidery by using the best materials. For our embroidered logos, we use a heavier backing paper that is "cut" away from the garment, rather than the cheaper "tear-away" paper. While tear-away backing paper is used by some embroidery companies, we believe it can distort the embroidery, so we always recommend using "cut-away" paper for better results.

CONSIDERATIONS FOR WHITE GARMENTS

Using cut-away paper ensures the longevity and quality of your embroidery. However, on white garments, the cut-away paper can sometimes be visible through the fabric, as shown in the image below. Despite this, we believe it is a small trade-off for achieving superior embroidery quality and durability.

Many leading brands like Adidas and Nike also use cut-away backing paper, as you may notice on your own garments from these brands. Even prominent individuals on TV and sports stars choose this method for the sake of quality. However, if you prefer tear-away paper, we can accommodate your request at the embroidery approval stage.

CUSTOMISATION OPTIONS

- Cut-Away Paper: Our standard choice for optimal embroidery quality. It may be visible on white garments, but it softens significantly after washing.

- **Trimmed Cut-Away Paper:** If visibility is an issue, we can trim the cut-away paper closer to the embroidery for an additional charge of approximately 30%. Many customers choose to trim the paper themselves upon delivery to their preferred specifications.
- **Tear-Away Paper:** While we do not recommend this option due to potential distortion, we can use tear-away paper if requested. Please inform us at the point of each order if you prefer this option.
